We have taken part in sports day where we loved racing and balancing bean bags on our heads and we also used our best voices to sing in the end of year show in front of everyone.

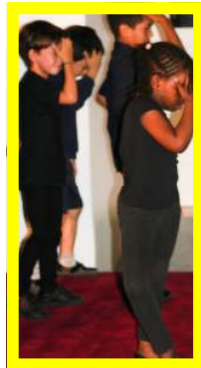
